Reflect and pray over this devotional thought from Pastor Wes...

I am completely okay with seeing flashing lights come towards me; however, I despise seeing flashing lights that are following me! My heart skips a beat when this happens! In any case, I think it's safe to say, when we are sitting in the driver's seat, we keep our eyes mostly fixed on what's ahead of us, than what's behind us.


